

Tompkins Township 2025 Master Land Use Plan 2015 Addendum – Proposed

The original community Vision, Goals and Policies contained in the Tompkins Township 2025 Master Land Use Plan are unchanged. Tompkins Township will remain an agriculture based township with its natural resources and rural character of prime importance.

Though virtually unchanged, this addendum will outline the minor changes in wording and statistics that appeared in the original plan and were gathered primarily from the 2010 US Census.

2010 US Census changes:

- The original document forecasted a 15.84% increase in township population from 2000 – 2010 of 437 residents however, actual census data indicates a reduction of residents of 87 or (3.2%). These changes reflect pages 8, 9, 10 & 18 of the master plan.
- At the same time, vacant housing units increased from 47 in 2000 to 88 in 2010. This change reflects page 16 of the master plan.

Miscellaneous Changes:

- In 2014 the Tompkins Township Board adopted support for the Agricultural Land Preservation Act. A copy of the adopted Tompkins Township Agricultural Land Preservation map is also contained in this addendum.
