SECTION 7. Homeowner Affidavit

I hereby certify the electrical work described on this permit application shall be installed by myself in my own home in which I am living or about to occupy. All work shall be installed in accordance with the Michigan Electrical Code and shall not be enclosed, covered up, or put into operation until it has been inspected and approved by the Tompkins Township Electrical Inspector. I will cooperate with the Tompkins Township Electrical Inspector and assume the responsibility to arrange for necessary inspections.

SECTION 8. INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETING APPLICATION

General: Electrical work shall not be started until the application for permit has been filed with Tompkins Township. All installation shall be in conformance with the Michigan Electrical Code. No work shall be concealed until it has been inspected. The telephone number for the inspector will be provided on the permit form. When ready for an inspection, call the inspector providing as much advance notice as possible. The inspector will need the job location and permit number.

Expiration of Permit: A permit remains valid as long as work is progressing and inspections are requested and conducted. A permit shall become invalid if the authorized work is not commenced within twelve (12) months after issuance of the permit or if the authorized work is suspended for a period of twelve (12) months after the time of commencing the work.

A PERMIT WILL BE CLOSED WHEN NO INSPECTIONS ARE REQUESTED AND CONDUCTED WITHIN TWELVE (12) MONTHS OF THE DATE OF ISSUANCE OR THE DATE OF A PREVIOUS INSPECTION. CLOSED PERMITS CANNOT BE REFUNDED OR REINSTATED.
