

*Tompkins Township*  
*Minutes*  
*January 6, 2022*

The regular meeting of the Tompkins Township Board was called to order at 7:00 p.m. in the township hall by Supervisor John A. Tuttle, Sr. followed by the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America. Members present in addition to the Supervisor were Clerk Melanie Curran, Treasurer Janine Baldwin, Trustee Nancy Seydell, and Trustee Mike Haydo. The minutes of the **December 2, 2021 Board meeting** were approved following a motion by Seydell, seconded by Baldwin. **Treasurer's report** was read as: Disbursements of \$38,283.84, deposits of \$64,271.95, and a balance of \$1,020,650.11. The report was accepted and placed on file following a motion by Haydo, seconded by Seydell. Motion carried. **Budget Amendments:** Approve Conditional Use Fee - Planning Commission Income increased \$13,000, and Planning Commission expense increased \$13,000 (\$3,000 and \$10,000) with the authority of the Appropriations Resolution by the Supervisor in November 2021 to cover P.C. legal costs, and approve \$2,000 transfer from Township Board expenses to Building Official Expenses, due to new account formed in different cost center, and approve \$1,000 Transfer from Township Board expense to Election Expense to cover new fees encountered for Dominion Election Equipment maintenance fees. Moved to approve all amendments by Curran, seconded by Baldwin Roll call votes: all yes. Motion carried.
