Pay all the bills and approve the post-audit bills as reported, moved by Baldwin, seconded by Haydo. Roll call yes votes: Haydo, Baldwin, Tuttle, Seydell, and Curran. No votes: none. Motion carried.

Fire Report – It was reported by the Chief the new pagers have a manufacturer issue with the micro USB charger and receivers inside the pager. Four have been sent in for repair. Request was made to purchase sixteen desktop chargers, unit price \$83.00 each, \$1,328.00 total. The chargers are essential for operation.

Public Comment was opened at 7:31 p.m. Comments were received and the meeting continued.

The Township shall continue to use County National as our depository bank for the next fiscal year.

Historical funding of the Cemetery – Tompkins is home to four cemeteries. If requests are received before the next meeting, moved by Curran, seconded by Haydo to preapprove and prepay \$500 to each cemetery as an annual expense the Township provides for historical preservation. Roll call: all yes. Motion carried.

Road Improvement - Moved by Tuttle, seconded by Seydell to approve road improvement of Snyder Rd., Arland Rd. to Rives Eaton Rd. projects as presented. The County will invoice the township \$50,000. this year, and the remaining due next year. Roll call votes: all yes. Motion carried.

Tire Collection – Moved by Tuttle, seconded by Curran to approve expense for tire collection, three workers, \$11.00 per hour up to \$180. on June 13th, 2020 and prepay. Roll call votes: all yes. Motion carried.

Public Comment was opened at 7:40 p.m. No additional comments were received, and the meeting continued.

One permit was issued this month for building activity.

The meeting was adjourned approximately 7:44 p.m. with four in attendance.
