Public Comment was opened at 7:16 p.m. Comments were received and the meeting continued.

Historical Donation to Cemeteries within Tompkins Township- Moved by Curran, seconded by Seydell to grant \$500 to each of the four cemeteries. Letters were received requesting the grant. Roll call votes: all yes. Motion carried.

Gutter Guards on the township hall – Tuttle requested up to \$800 for installation of gutter guards for the township hall and submitted one bid, unless another bid is received. Roll call votes: all yes, except Curran voted no. Motion carried.

Resolution for the County of Jackson, Release of Right of First Refusal – Two parcels available on the foreclosure list for Tompkins Township. Moved by Curran, seconded by Haydo to approve the Release of First Right of Refusal Resolution. Roll call votes: all yes. Motion carried.

Board Policy – The cost for funeral dinners or community events by a non-resident shall be a regular non-resident rental fee with deposit. Moved by Tuttle, seconded by Seydell. Motion carried.

Public Comment was opened at 8:01 p.m. Additional comments were received, and the meeting continued.

Eight permits were issued this month for building activity.

The meeting was adjourned approximately 8:08 p.m. with five in attendance.
