Moved by Tuttle, seconded by Curran to approach Rives Township to fund the purchase of the SCBA gear at 100%. Motion carried by voice vote. **Old Engine 3** – Moved by Tuttle, seconded by Seydell to move ahead with trying to sell the old Engine 3, continue with negotiations looking for a buyer, and gather pricing information. Roll call votes: all yes, except Curran. Motion passed.

Region 2 Membership and Annual GIS Contribution- Moved by Seydell, seconded by Haydo to decline membership and GIS Contribution again. Roll call votes: all yes. Motion carried.

Public Comment was opened at 8:14 p.m. Comments were received and the meeting continued. Fourteen permits were issued this month for building activity. The meeting was adjourned at 8:16 p.m. with eight in attendance.
