Application for Farmland and Open Space Preservation Program by JoAnna M. Rogers Trust was presented for approval. Motion to approve by Woodburn, seconded by Tuttle. Roll call votes: all yes. Motion carried.

Body Camera Purchase- Michigan Township Participating Plan agrees to fund a Grant for a body camera in the amount of \$1,500.00. Motion to accept the grant, and fund the remaining cost by Woodburn, seconded by Tuttle. Roll call votes: all yes. Motion carried.

Agreement with Drake Certified Public Accountants, PC – Moved by Tuttle, seconded by Seydell to agree to the terms of engagement with Drake CPA, PC and sign the contract. Roll call votes: all yes. Motion carried.

Poverty Exemptions discussion occurred. It is expected and agreed the Poverty Exemption Resolution in December 2025 will include operative clauses to require documents to confirm assets reported for exemption status.

<u>Public Comment</u> was opened at 7:49 p.m. Comments were received and the meeting continued. Twenty six permits were issued this month for building activity. The meeting at 8:38 p.m. with four in attendance.
