February 5, 2026

The regular meeting of the Tompkins Township Board was called to order at 7:00 p.m. in the township hall by Supervisor Chuck Woodburn followed by the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America. Members present in addition to the Supervisor were Clerk Melanie Curran, Treasurer Janine Baldwin, Trustee John A. Tuttle, Sr., and Trustee Nancy L. Seydell. The minutes of the **January 8, 2026 Regular Board meeting** were approved following a motion by Seydell, seconded by Baldwin. **Treasurer's report** was read as: Total disbursements of \$87,642.20, deposits of \$76,682.14, and a balance of \$678,001.80. The report was moved to accept and place on file following a motion by Tuttle, seconded by Seydell. Motion carried. **Vouchers for the fire department** were read by the Supervisor.

Wage Resolution: Moved by Tuttle, seconded by Seydell to increase Clerk and Treasurer wages to \$27,468 annual, Supervisor \$20,484 annual, and Trustee per diem will be \$191 effective April 1, 2026. Each position has a separate resolution. Roll call votes: all yes. Motion carried.

Budget Workshop: scheduled for March 16, 2026 11:00 a.m. and **Budget meeting** for March 30, 2026, 11:00 a.m. as discussed and agreed upon by the Board.

Resolution for 2026-2027 Meeting Dates: All meeting dates will be the first Thursday after the first Monday. Moved to adopt the monthly meeting dates as presented and discussed by Curran, seconded by Baldwin. Roll call votes: all yes. Motion carried.

Road Projects for 2026 discussion occurred.

SEMCO Energy Gas Company Franchise, Ordinance 47D – Moved by Tuttle, seconded by Seydell to approve and pass Non-Zoning Ordinance 47D granting SEMCO Energy Gas Company a gas franchise and publish. Effective 30 days after publication. Roll call votes: all yes. Motion carried. Publish date: February 10, 2026 in the Jackson Citizen Patriot.

Public Comment was opened at 8:06 p.m. No comments were received and the meeting continued.

Five permits were issued this month for building activity.

The meeting was adjourned approximately 8:08 p.m. with five in attendance.
