Special Meeting Minutes
Purpose: Budget 2026- 2027
March 2026

March 16, 2026

The special workshop meeting of the Tompkins Township Board was called to order at 11:00 a.m. in the Tompkins Township hall, 9999 Tompkins Rd., Rives Junction, by Supervisor Chuck Woodburn. Members present in addition to the Supervisor were Clerk Melanie Curran, Treasurer Janine Baldwin, Trustee John A. Tuttle, Sr. and Trustee Nancy Seydell. The budget was discussed and worked out.

Topics of Discussion: Town hall Scheduler Job Description, Town hall rental fee, Interest rates are going down, roads, and farm land. Fire Department expense will increase due to payroll, but the budget amount left the same. Election equipment is at the end of the ten year contract for use. Three elections scheduled with two having 9 days of early voting. Audit will occur this year.

Public Comment was offered. No comments were received. No one from the public was in attendance. The meeting was adjourned at 1:50 p.m.

General Appropriations Act (Budget) 2026-2027 Resolution was read by all. Moved by Curran, seconded by Tuttle to adopt the resolution. Roll call votes: all yes. Motion carried. Resolution adopted.

Post Audit Policy Resolution was updated. Moved by Curran, seconded by Baldwin. Roll call votes: all yes. Motion carried.

Recreation Passport Grant Resolution giving support to submit for a grant moved by Curran, seconded by Woodburn. Roll call votes: all yes. Motion carried.

Deputy Wages – Moved by Baldwin, seconded by Tuttle to increase deputy wages to \$19 per hour. Roll call votes: all yes. Motion carried.

Election Worker Wages – moved to increase Election Worker wages to \$18 per hour by Woodburn, seconded by Tuttle. Roll call votes: all yes. Motion carried.

Mileage Rate – Moved to use the IRS recommended rate for Mileage reimbursement. Roll call vote: all yes. Motion carried.

Public Comments were invited. The meeting adjourned at 11:30 a.m. with zero in attendance.
